Redstone will provide the funds, Neighborhood Concepts will make the loans, and The Catalyst will provide loan support services before and after the loan is made.

Many of these are small shops and start-ups that need immediate access to microloans to stay afloat until the next big order or contract comes through,” said Joe Newberry, president and CEO of Redstone Federal Credit Union. “Redstone is proud to partner with these two non-profits to provide that much-needed funding boost and give these businesses a better chance at success.”
